

EditStor ES with Avid® Project Sharing Description

EditStor ES now offers the native media and project sharing that normally only exists when using Avid® shared storage solutions. As such, it is cross-platform (MAC and Windows) and transparent to your Avid® workflow.

When you place your projects on EditStor ES project sharing enabled volumes, multiple users can work on the same project at the same time. Using native bin locking, Avid® editors do not have to keep track of who is currently working in a bin - the lock shows you.



The first person who opens the bin has the right to write, thus the green open lock. The bin is red and locked for other users. This method allows one user to write to a bin while multiple users can read the files in that bin. This further ensures that changes to clips or sequences aren't inadvertently overwritten by multiple users. Locked users can edit the sequences but must save a copy in a different bin if they don't have permission to write to that bin.
